## **Results of the Kengro Biosorb Project**

Results are averages of two samples taken from each specimen bag.

### **Kengro Biosorb**

Total of eight types of bacteria isolated. There were three types of Gram-negative rods and five types of Gram-positive rods present. The five types of Gram-positive rods were all in the genus *Bacillus*. The three types of Gram-negative rods were all non-lactose fermenting environmental isolates.

Total count=>2,351,000 cfu/gram Kengro Biosorb

Gram-negative rods:

Type 1 =>2,000,000 cfu/gram

Type 2 =~50,000 cfu/gram

Type 3 =~50,000 cfu/gram

Type 4 =~1000 cfu/gram

Five types of *Bacillus* spp. At~250,000 cfu/gram
